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RESOLUTION 2017-5

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING DURANGO FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT COORDINATED NOVEMBER 7, 2017 ELECTION

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Durango Fire Protection District has determined that a coordinated election with La Plata County and San Juan County will be held on November 7, 2017 (“Election”); and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of the Special District Act (“Act”) and the Colorado Uniform Election Code of 1992 (“Code”), the Election will be conducted to present a ballot question pursuant to Article X, Section 20 of the Colorado Constitution, also referred to as the Taxpayer’s Bill of Rights (“TABOR”).

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Directors of the Durango Fire Protection District in the counties of La Plata and San Juan, State of Colorado, that:

1. There will be a special coordinated election of the eligible electors of the District held on November 7, 2017, between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 7:00 P.M. pursuant to and in accordance with the Act, Code and other applicable laws.

2. The La Plata County Clerk and San Juan County Clerk shall conduct mail ballot elections (respectively). “Mail Ballot Election” means an election for which eligible electors receive ballots by mail and vote by mailing those ballots, depositing the ballots at, as applicable, drop-off locations or voter service and polling centers, or, as applicable, by voting at a voter service and polling center. The mail ballot elections shall be conducted in accordance with the Act, the Code, TABOR and all other applicable laws.

3. The Designated Election Official appointed herein is authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with the County Clerk of La Plata County, Colorado and County Clerk of San Juan County, Colorado on behalf of the District, which agreement shall include provisions for the allocation of responsibilities for the conduct and reasonable sharing of costs of the coordinated Election

4. The Board of Directors hereby designates CJ Weaver as the Designated Election Official of the District, who is hereby authorized and directed to proceed with any action necessary or appropriate to effectuate the provisions of this Resolution and the Act, Code, or other applicable laws. The Election shall be conducted in accordance with the Act, Code, TABOR and other applicable laws.

5. If any part or provision of this Resolution is adjudged to be unenforceable or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remaining provisions of this Resolution, it being the Board’s intention that the various provisions hereof are severable.

6. Any and all actions previously taken by the Designated Election Official or the Secretary of the Board of Directors or any other persons acting on their behalf pursuant to the Act, the Code or other applicable laws, are hereby ratified and confirmed.

7. All acts, orders, and resolutions, or parts thereof, of the Board which are inconsistent or in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency or conflict.

8. The provisions of this Resolution shall take effect immediately.
