**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING INTEGRATED PROJECT DELIVERY FOR
THE DURANGO FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT TRAINING SITE PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the Durango Fire Protection District ("District") is a quasimunicipal corporation and political subdivision of the State of Colorado and a duly organized and existing special district pursuant to Title 32, Colorado Revised Statutes; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Part 18 of the Special District Act, the District is authorized to procure public improvements via integrated project delivery and award contracts on a "best value" rather than "lowest responsible, responsive bid" basis; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors ("Board") of the District has reviewed and considered the various challenges and opportunities relevant to the completion of the District's Training Site project; and

WHEREAS, the Board hereby finds and determines that integrated project delivery represents a timely and cost-effective alternative for delivery of the District's Training Site project, that is further expected to reduce contracting and cost risk to the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Durango Fire Protection District as follows:

1. **Authority to Use Integrated Project Delivery.** The Board hereby finds and determines that integrated project delivery represents a timely and cost-effective alternative for the District's Training Site project.
2. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall take effect and be enforced immediately upon its approval by the District Board.
