



# Interfacility Transport Ambulance EMT

Durango Fire Protection District (DFPD) believes that hiring qualified individuals to fill positions contributes to the overall strategic success of DFPD. Each employee, while employed, is hired to make significant contributions to DFPD.

We are currently taking applications for an **EMT, EMT-A, or EMT-I** to staff the Interfacility Transport Ambulance. We have multiple full-time temporary positions available. Approximately mid-April to mid-September. Starting hourly rate is \$19.58.

**Minimum Qualifications to apply:** High School Diploma or GED, Colorado EMT, a valid driver's license and ability to work 12-hour shifts, with some overtime expected.

**Preferred Qualifications:** Colorado IFSAC Hazmat Awareness

To be considered for the testing process the following items are due by **Friday, April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022 at 1200:**

1. Application for Employment – all sections completed
2. Resume and cover letter
3. Copy of certifications verifying current EMT level.

The testing process will consist of a written test including EMS questions, an EMS skills assessment, a moderate physical component, and an oral interview. **The testing process will take place at a date and time to be determined.**

Job offer is contingent upon on successful completion of a background check, drug test and physical.
