



# Interfacility Transport Ambulance EMT or Paramedic

Durango Fire Protection District (DFPD) believes that hiring qualified individuals to fill positions contributes to the overall strategic success of DFPD. Each employee, while employed, is hired to make significant contributions to DFPD.

We are currently taking applications for a full-time, benefited **EMT, EMT-A, EMT-I or Paramedic** to staff the Interfacility Transport Ambulance. Starting hourly rate is \$25.25 for EMT or \$30.88 for Paramedic.

**Minimum Qualifications to apply:** High School Diploma or GED, Colorado EMT or Paramedic, a valid driver's license and ability to work 12-hour shifts, with some overtime expected.

**Preferred Qualifications:** Colorado IFSAC Hazmat Awareness

To be considered for the testing process the following items are due by **Wednesday, February 14th at 1600:**

2. Copy of certifications verifying current EMS level, if not currently on file.

The testing process will consist of a written test including EMS questions, an EMS skills assessment, a moderate physical component, and an oral interview. **The testing process will take place at a date and time to be determined.**
